The quality of the papers is initially assessed based on the synopsis. To this end, the synopsis must summarize the background and goal of the paper, the main methods used and present the main results and advances that will be described in the paper. It should be about **500 words** and maximum **two pages**. A synopsis that only describes the context of the research will be rejected.

The synopsis must be in English. As a convention, UK English is used in CIGRE papers.
